USG Goes Global (USGG) is fully aware of growing concern regarding <u>COVID-19</u> and has been closely monitoring information from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Department of State regarding guidance for study abroad programs. At this time the **«Program\_Name»** program is scheduled to run as planned. Please be aware, however, that if the CDC assigns a <u>level 3</u> warning to any program it will be cancelled. **Currently, no USGG destination has been assigned** *any* **CDC warning level regarding COVID-19 which means they have determined there is no additional risk of traveling to any USGG program location due to COVID-19 at this time**. We do understand that you may have your own concerns regarding travel this summer, and we assure you that if you feel uncomfortable about participating in your program due to COVID-19 concerns that we will either

a) allow you to switch to a <u>different USGG program location</u> that is still accepting students at this time at no penalty or

b) refund you for any USGG payments you have made thus far.

If you wish to take either of these actions due to COVID-19 concerns, you must make this decision by Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup> and notify Ms. Margaret Mullins in writing by email at <u>margaret.mullins@usg.edu</u>. After March 18<sup>th</sup> we will reassess each program and send new communication regarding your options.

As a reminder, each participant on a USGG program will have a robust health insurance policy through CISI (plan information available <u>here</u>).

Lastly, USG Goes Global does not offer program cancellation insurance or have any specific recommendation for cancellation insurance. However, if you are concerned about COVID-19 but wish to wait until after March 18<sup>th</sup> to make a final decision, you may wish to look into cancellation insurance policies available on the market.

If you have concerns regarding your program for this summer and COVID-19 please contact me or your <u>USGG institutional representative</u>. If you must cancel participation in a USGG program for any other reason, the published cancellation policy will still apply to you.
