Mamak (Malaysian) This is also one of the hot new places that everyone's flocking to. Because it's small, it can be crowded during dinner. Top pics: Brisket or Sweet & Sour Chicken.

King Skewer Skewers are the spicy side, but the won ton soup (hand made on the spot) is a real treat.

Across the Street from Asian Square (Right)

Northern China Eatery 5141 Buford Hwy (Right) Directly across from Asian Square

Look for Italy Optical Store at street level; restaurant is down the hill on the side.

Not sure standard southern Chinese fare, this small place (but not packed) is big on taste with steamed dumplings.

I Love Pho (Vietnamese) | 5145 Buford Hwy (Right)

Just one of MANY Vietnamese restaurants on Buford, but also one of the largest.

PINE TREE PLAZA | 5289 Buford Hwy (Right)

Bo Bo Garden This large restaurant with a large menu is where you'll find Chinese Americans on the weekend.

North of I-285 Overpass

Kang Nam (Korean owned Japanese Restaurant; est. 1970) | 5715 Buford Hwy RIGHT

Big portions at good prices. Traditional Japanese food with Korean side dishes.

White Windmill Café& Bakery | 5881 Buford Hwy RIGHT

Stone Bowl House | 5953 Buford Hwy RIGHT Another top pic; tradition bibimbap cooked in a clay pot.

Super H-Mart Shopping Plaza

Going north on Buford Hwy, turn left on Frontage Road right before I-285 Overpass (just past QT / Quick Trip)

Go ¾ Mile to Brands Mart (just past Nissan) and Turn Left toward H-Mart Parking Lot
