



2017-2018 SIOP-CEMA Mentoring Program

The Committee for Ethnic Minority Affairs (CEMA) is launching a mentor program that aims to increase racial/ethnic minority student engagement in SIOP. Through the development of mentoring relationships, graduate students will be provided with the information and advice needed to launch successful careers. In this program, a SIOP-member mentor meets (via phone, internet, or in-person) regularly with a mentee(s) to discuss research, career-related topics, graduate school-related topics, or other professional issues of interest (e.g., academic vs. practitioner careers, building a consulting practice, publishing in top journals). It is left up to mentors and mentees to determine the specific topics they wish to cover in their meetings, tailored to mentors' specific experience/expertise and mentee interests/needs.
